Pursuant to rule 68A-9.004(3) in the Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), this written authorization allows the above named permittee and approved group members to access the management area listed below as long as permittee adheres to the following conditions and provisions:

### Access is granted for Three Lakes

FWC Permission Granted: Approved to access Three Lakes/Prairie Lakes, Bull Creek to conduct a running event.

### **Representing RUN BUM TOURS**

- 1. This authorization must be in the physical possession of the participant while accessing the management area and must be presented to any law enforcement officer, Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission personnel or Forest Service personnel upon request.
- 2. This authorization is subject to revocation prior to the expiration date pursuant to Chapter 120, Florida Statutes.
- 3. Application for renewal should be made at least 30 days in advance of the date it is needed.
- 4. This authorization supersedes any previous permit or authorization issued by the Commission to the participant for special access to a Management Area.
- 5. Acceptance of this permit by the permittee constitutes agreement to abide by all provisions of this permit and all the rules and regulations relating to the Management Areas and wildlife within those Management Areas.
- 6. Participant acknowledges that other allowable recreational uses may take place on the Property during the same time period as prescribed by this Authorization. Participant may use the Property to the extent required to carry on the activity for which the use is requested and shall not prevent the general public or any other authorized users or lessees from carrying on their approved activities. Participant acknowledges that this Authorization does not permit exclusive use of the Property or facilities within the Property. Participant also acknowledges that this Authorization does not bestow any authority on the Participant to regulate the actions of the general public using the Property who are not involved in this event.
- 7. Participant is under a duty to be vigilant for Participant's own safety as well as the safety of others. Participant understands and agrees that Participant is responsible for Participant's personal safety and the personal safety of any and all persons accompanying Participant on the Property or accessing the Property under the direction of Participant. Participant is fully knowledgeable of the risks that are generally associated with traversing Property that is in a substantially natural condition and assumes all such risks.

- Participant also assumes all risks associated with traversing FWC lands "as is". Participant voluntarily assumes any other risks, of every kind whatsoever, whether natural or artificial, while conducting activities on the Property pursuant to this Authorization.
- 8. FWC has reviewed this request and determines that this activity as restricted by this Authorization will not in FWC's judgment cause unacceptable adverse impact to the natural resources or cause significant conflict with permitted uses of the property. Participant will not cause impacts, harm or alterations to FWC lands, facilities, or equipment.
- 9. FWC staff may periodically inspect the Property used by Participant permitted under this Authorization to identify any impacts or damage to the Property caused by the authorized activity.
- 10. Participant is solely responsible for obtaining any permits or other forms of authorization required by law from federal, state or local governmental entities in order to engage in the activities that are the subject of this Authorization. Participant shall comply with all laws, statutes, ordinances and rules applicable to the activity authorized by this Authorization.
- 11. Participant will clean and restore the Property at the conclusion of each activity permitted under this Authorization to not less than its condition immediately prior to the commencement of the authorized activity. Participant will also repair any damage to FWC property resulting from each activity permitted under this Authorization at the expense of the Participant.
- 12. The signatory executing this Authorization on behalf of Participant hereby warrants and represents that he/she shall advise any participants of activities authorized herein of the terms and conditions of this Authorization prior to their engaging in any use of the Property.
- 13. Must follow County Dept of Health requirements for portable restrooms and hand-washing stations.
- 14. Must have all required local and state permits for food, beverage, and other vendors and follow any local ordinances that govern food preparation and sales.
- 15. Must utilize approved parking areas and provide directional signs or staff to direct attendees to parking.
- 16. Must provide adequate trash receptacles and remove all trash, signage, trail signs, etc. at end of the event.
- 17. Participant will provide FWC with proof of general liability insurance covering personal injury and property damage naming the FWC as an additional insured. Limits shall be set at appropriate levels, but shall be, at a minimum, \$200,000 per person and \$300,000 per occurrence. The Participant shall notify FWC at least thirty (30) days prior to cancellation or modification of any insurance required by this Authorization. Insurance required under this Authorization will contain a provision that it may not be cancelled or modified until thirty (30) days after written notice to FWC.
- 18. Participant shall be responsible for having every person who participates in the authorized activity execute a waiver of liability and indemnification in the form attached prior to engaging in the activity. Participant shall deliver the original fully executed Liability Releases to FWC as described.
- 19. Permittee shall either hand-deliver or mail the original fully executed Liability Releases by January 25th, 2020 to: FWC, Attention Matthew Hortman, NE Regional Office, 1239 SW 10th Street, Ocala, FL 34471. - 20. All support vehicles, trailers and other support equipment shall remain on designated roadways and parking areas and shall not be used off roads. Support vehicles and trailers shall be parked in a manner that shall not exclude the use of Bull Creek and Three Lakes/Prairies Lakes WMA's by the public for extended periods and shall accommodate public use as necessary.
- 21. Small game hunting will be on-going on Bull Creek and Three Lakes/Prairie Lakes WMA's during the permitted activity. It is recommended that support staff and race participants wear flourescent orange or other bright clothing while traversing the WMA's for added safety. Efforts shall be made to not unduly disturb the public that are actively hunting along the route.
